



Formula 3 Australian Championship : Adelaide Clipsal 500

1st Round / 1st -2nd March 2014

Historic hat-trick for Mygale and Simon Hodge / BRM in the Australian Formula 3 Championship first round.

For the first round of the season in F3 Australian Drivers Championship, **Simon Hodge / BRM** just flew over practice sessions with his **Mygale** and **earned the pole position** in the qualifying, with not only setting a best lap record but also **smashing the historic track record in 1'18"28**, and **brilliantly won the 3 races in a row**.

If **Hodge** wins the first race by more than 5 seconds, his closest challengers, Gersekowski and **Arrie Maree / Harvest Motorsport** with his **Mygale**, are really close in the second one.

Maree, after he had to run the qualifying with a broken hydraulic brake line, manages to **finish with a 3rd place in the second race** and a 4th and 5th in the others, thus coming 4th in Championship class debut, with only a 4 points gap down the 3rd.

The 3rd race, anyway, is very special and a true battle between Hodge and Gersekowski from the start line. **Hodge in the end manages to escape and wins the race**, taking the advantage and by the meantime being **launched to the head of the Championship by 18 points**.



The next round the Formula 3 championship will be held on Sandown Raceway on the 28th and 29th of March 2014, and **this time there will be 3 Mygale Cars**, **John Magro** having decided to switch to a **Mygale** for the next races.
