New Zealand Formula Ford Championship Taupo, March 8th&9th, 2014, Final Round

JAMIE CONROY WINS FORMULA FORD CHAMPIONSHIP WITH HIS MYGALE

Jamie **Conroy/Neale Motorsport** is the 2013/2014 New Zealand Formula Ford Champion. Conroy went to **Taupo** with a 97 point lead over Michael Collins and started the weekend with the fastest time in Saturday morning's qualifying session to take pole position for Saturday afternoon's 10 lap race. **Conroy** was quickly into the lead in the first race, pulling away to win by over six seconds from Collins.

That extended Jamie's points lead to 105 points and victory in the second race of the round early on Sunday gave him an unassailable lead in the championship. In winning the title Conroy become one of only a select few who have achieved the feat in their rookie year. After sealing the title Conroy was back on track for Sunday afternoon's final race over 12 laps to take another victory, his sixteenth out of eighteen races. In a dominant season he also won five of the six rounds that constitute the championship. It was only at the fourth round at Hampton Downs that motor problems in two races cost him the chance to clean sweep the championship.



Conroy and the team will now focus on the final round of the South Island Formula Ford Championship which will be decided at **Mike Pero Motorsport Park** at Ruapuna in Christchurch in a fortnight. Collins narrowly leads Conroy in that title race. **Aaron Marr** is also to be distinguished: he earned a well-deserved 3rd place in the New-Zealand championship with his **Mygale**, thus setting the only two Mygale of the championship onto the podium.
