

South East Asia: a new Championship for FIA F4 Mygale again!

2016 is set to be a great year for FIA F4 Mygale. After UK, Australia, Chine and Mexico, South East Asia launches its FIA F4 Championship while the 4 other Championships are at their heights.

Promoter *Asian Autosport Action Group* (**Triple A**) announced end November the **FIA-certified Formula 4 South East Asia Championship (F4SEA)** for 2016. Last 13th December in Sepang the official Promotor of F4 in South East Asia, *Peter Thomson* Chairman **Triple A** and *Firhat Mokhzani*, Managing Director **Triple A** unveiled **Mygale** as the official supplier of this new Championship. 2016 will get off to a great start in Magny-Cours factory with the completion of 20 new **FIA Formula 4**!

The season is scheduled for July 2016 with rounds in Malaysia, Indonesia, Philippines, Thailand and Taiwan. The full calendar will be announced at a later date.

"The FIA Formula 4 SEA is a unique "one" concept: One-team, one-make, one-data for one low cost. This gives a real basis for all those young drivers that have come out of karting. It is the first step in the ladder towards higher levels of motorsport. The financial barrier from karting to other racing formula is removed. Not only thanks to Mygale the latest existing technology is applied to the chassis, but also makes the championship cheaper than most international kart championships," said Firhat Mokhzani, Managing Director of Triple A.

A well-filled calendar until the launch of this new Championship: China will celebrate the final of the Chinese Formula 4 Championship in January in Zhuhai, the second season of the MSA Formula Championship will start in UK in April, and the F4 NACAM Championship has been going on in Mexico until June.
