



## Scott/Falcon & Kruger/JTR on top together with Rosso/Radical & Mealin/Falcon

On Saturday, June, 7th, in the 10th round of Formula Ford Championship of Great-Britain, Harrison Scott/Falcon Motorsports, not only set the pole position but also claimed his second race victory of the season. He seized control of the race at the start and held off a determined challenge from championship leader Jayde Kruger/JTR all the way to the chequered flag despite damp conditions. Third place went to Juan Rosso/Radical.

In the 11<sup>th</sup> round shortened due to rain and a few accidents, Jayde Kruger and Harrison Scott reversed their positions from the day's earlier Oulton Park race, Kruger taking the lead ahead of Harrison Scott and Chris Mealin/Falcon Motorsports. Chris Mealin took over the lead of the Scholarship class in addition to finding himself on the overall podium.

Jayde Kruger and Harrison Scott maintained their stranglehold on the Championship podium's top steps in round 12, Kruger leading Scott from pole position to chequered flag to claim his second win of the weekend and maintain his championship advantage over his main rival. Kruger rocketed away on the opening lap to build a 1.1-second advantage in his Mygale, and he stayed ahead by a similar margin throughout the whole race, even breaking his day-old lap record along the way. Rosso, though his Mygale was badly damaged in Round 11, scored his second podium finish of the weekend by finishing 3<sup>rd</sup>.

## US F1600 Formula F Championship Series VIRginia Raceway, 7-8 June 2014, Round 3

## Brandon Newey sets pole position twice and wins once, 6 Mygale cars on top in each race

On Saturday, June, 7<sup>th</sup>, in the 3<sup>rd</sup> round of US F1600 Series at Virginia International Raceway, **Brandon Newey/Chastain Motorsports** in his **Mygale** rocketed to pole position in the qualifying, even setting the fastest lap and breaking the track record. He then continued his F1600 comeback with a victory in Saturday's race, leading from the start to the chequered flag, but it was another race coming down to the last lap since **Ayla Agren/Team Pelfrey** kept stuck to Newey's car in the very last lap, trying to get past him. **Agren** waited to the last second, pulling out coming to the chequered flags, only to be denied to her first F1600 victory by .042 seconds as the two **Mygale** battled to the finish. Another driver of **Team Pelfrey, Garth Rickards**, completed the podium of Saturday's race.

On Sunday's qualifying, **Brandon Newey** continued an impressive F1600 Championship Series weekend with his second pole in two days, by a slim margin over **Nikita Lastochkin/Team Pelfrey** and his teammate **Ayla Agren**. **Sam Chastain**, **Newey**'s teammate and **Steve Bamford/Rice Race Prep** completed the top five in VIR **qualifying in an all-Mygale top-seven sweep**. In the second race of the week-end, **Steve Bamford** drafted past **Brandon Newey**, and as the race developed used all his experience to remain in the top-three, timing the last lap to near perfection and denying **Newey** a weekend sweep for Chastain Motorsports, thus taking his first F1600 Championship Series victory. **Nikita Lastochkin** was third in a **Mygale** podium sweep.

Help to the teams **Pelfrey**, **Chastain** and **Rice Race Prep**, each race ended in an **all-Mygale top-six sweep**.

Next round on 4-6 July at Mid-Ohio.
