

New Zealand Formula Ford Championship – Mainfeild Circuit February 8 & 9th 2014 – Round 5

Jamie Conroy maintains his supremacy over the Championship with his Mygale

Jamie Conroy, the driver from Invercargill with his Mygale n°23, shows again his determination to keep his leading position over the New Zealand Championship. He now won 13 races as the 5th round is over, amongst them all three latest races at Mainfeild Circuit. He did won all three races in one round earlier in the season too, at Timaru, where he took the pole position in qualifying and then lead every lap of the week-end ending in his winning of all races. At Manfeild Circuit, Jamie Conroy managed to win with more than 6 seconds over Aaron Marr, Wanganui's driver, with his Mygale n°11. Aaron Marr himself being more than one second ahead of Michael Collins, the direct rival to Jamie Conroy in the championship.

Aaron Marr consistently finishes in the 4th best drivers in each race, even achieving a win with his Mygale at Hampton Downs with more than 5 seconds over Jamie Conroy.



As a consequence of their consistency, Jamie Conroy is not only keeping his leadership in the championship but is extending his lead by nearly 100 points over Michael Collins, his closest rival. Aaron Marr keeps his third position in the championship.

In the twelve to sixteen cars racing in the New Zealand Championship, there are two Mygale – brilliantly driven and both on the actual championship podium.

Next Round will be held at Taupo on the 8 & 9th of March. We wish all the possible luck to Jamie Conroy and Aaron Marr.
